
2 Install the Intel mounting brackets to the fixing point of the radiator.




3 Remove the fan before installing radiator.




4 Remove the protective film. Spread a layer of thermal paste evenly on the motherboard CPU chip.




6 Align the holes on the Intel brackets, place the radiator on the screw posts, and then lock the radiator on the screw posts with the spring nuts.




7 Install the fan on the radiator, paying attention to the airflow direction.








1 Remove the fan before installing radiator.




2 Install the AMD mounting brackets to the fixing point of the radiator, and then remove the protective film.
